Planet in Peril: Polar Ice Update

Mark Serreze, senior research scientist, National Snow and Ice Data Center, Cooperative Institute for Research in Environmental Sciences (CIRES), University of Colorado at Boulder

Just up the road in Boulder, scientists are noting that the Arctic is in trouble. Researchers say that the cause appears to be greenhouse gas-induced global warming. Serreze and others have been tracking the dramatic reduction in Arctic ice over the past five years. They explain that this is an early warning indicator of bigger changes to come and that global warming is not 50 years down the road—it's starting now. Serreze will explain the significance of this drastic Arctic ice reduction and discuss ways that you can help make a difference for a planet in peril.
