- Are the problems and the goals clearly stated and motivated?
- Are the inputs and outputs of the projects clearly states?
- Is the strategy and algorithm clearly described?
- Is the approach appropriate and likely to succeed?
- Are the expected results clear, and is there clear discussion of how they will be interpreted?

Report Review Criteria

- Is the report well organized and written clearly?
- Are the goals, motivation, and methods clear?
- Are all figures and tables clear, complete, and potentially publishable?
- Are the results clear, and are they clearly and reasonably interpreted?
- Was reasonable progress made on solving the problem?
